



## Flagler Memorial Bridge Update

### September 26, 2013

On Monday, Sept. 30, the contractor for the Flagler Memorial Bridge Replacement Project, PCL, will begin removing sections of the ramp from northbound Flagler Drive to the eastbound bridge to begin foundation work for the new bridge in this area. This work will be performed during daytime hours (7 a.m. – 5 p.m.) and requires cutting and removing concrete sections of the ramp. ***Area residents might experience increased noise during this work, which is expected to last approximately two weeks, weather permitting.***

Please note that this work is currently scheduled for daytime hours only. However, could shift to nighttime hour if necessary due to unforeseen circumstances. Advance notification will be provided prior to any removal work at night.

**On Tuesday, Oct. 1**, between 8:30 a.m. and 12:30p.m., workers will complete a power transfer from the south side of the bridge to the north side in preparation for foundation work in the west lagoon area. During this transfer, the bridge will be operating on generator power to raise and lower the spans and openings are expected to last slightly longer than usual. ***This work is being performed by FPL and their contractor and they will reschedule this work if necessary.***
